Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Romans 13:1-7, Acts 4:18-20 "Politics"

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question.)
Read Romans 13:1-7 together.

- 1. Politics today can be a divisive subject in most environments. Do you think we should be discussing this within the church? Why or why not?
- 2. How often is the word "authority"/ "authorities" mentioned in these verses? Why would Paul bring this subject into the church to understand?
- 3. Does verse 1 make sense for you today, in all and every society? What is difficult to understand? What is easy to understand and accept and why?
- 4. How does it make you feel that God speaks to government and authority within the Bible?
- 5. Is there ever a time this passage of Scripture could be difficult to carry out? Any examples come to mind? Read Acts 4:18-20 to see if Christians must always submit to the governing body over them.
- 6. After going through this study, is there one overarching them you can summarize this passage by? Discuss this before closing in prayer.

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
