Read aloud together Proverbs 4:18-27

- 1. What type of theme or big idea can you take away from this passage?
- 2. In verses 18-19, discuss the result of living in the light as opposed to following the way of darkness.
- 3. Discuss why the author focuses on the heart and why he emphasizes its importance in verses 21-23.
- 4. Does society at large "guard their heart"? What is the way a believer should "guard their heart" and what would be the result of an unguarded heart?
- 5. Look at each verse in 24-27 and give the practical ways from each verse we let our heart be unguarded.(Mouth, lips, eyes, feet)
- 6. How easy is it for you to guard your heart in today's world? What are the reasons for that? How will you apply these truths in your life this week?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
